Dr. Haitham F. Dowiri, Community Medicine Specialist is the current acting director of Organizational Development and Quality Control Directorate in Jordan Ministry of Health (MOH) since May 2018. As a Director of Development and Quality, Dr. Dowiri has been focused on improving healthcare quality, reducing costs, enhancing efficiency, improving satisfaction and preventing harm. He has special interest in using tools to identify weaknesses in systems that may contribute to errors or suboptimal quality of care and effective use of multidisciplinary teams in driving quality and safety efforts.

Prior to being appointed as the Director of Organizational Development and Quality Control Directorate, Dr. Hytham was the Director of Quality from April 2017 to May 2018. He had joined MOH in 2002 as an Emergency Doctor at Al-Ramtha Hospital and then was promoted to Head of Standards Development Department in 2013.
