Aligned with HCAC's mission and social responsibility, and in accordance with the evaluation results of both the NQSGSs and Quality Competition, a new methodology is proposed encompassing both the goals and the competition as improvement tools under one umbrella: "HCAC National Quality and Safety Goals".

In 2024, the HCAC Quality and Safety Goals Journey will be divided into two pathways: (1) Focused Quality and Safety Goals Assessment. (2) Quality Competition.

The initial pathway will cater to non-accredited organizations, and the latter pathway will be tailored for accredited organizations.

These two initiatives led by HCAC, enhance the engagement of organizations in friendly competition to elevate the strive for excellence in quality and building a culture of safety.



HCAC conducted an evaluation for the NQSGSs program, and of the important outcomes were to national initiative towards improving health care sector in Jordan, to expand the goals to more healthcare institutions and to give more awareness for the program at the national level.
